## **Home Electrical System Check**

Important measurements are taken and monitored annually to uncover electrical concerns before they turn into major inconveniences or safety hazards. In addition, our expert technicians will keep you informed about new and exciting technologies so your home is always on the cutting edge of safety, efficiency, and convenience.

### Visual System Check

We will visually check readily accessible areas of your home's wiring system and associated devices for the following conditions:

- ✓ Loose or damaged wiring connections.
- Abnormal wear and tear to wiring and point of use devices.
- Insecure mounting or attachment of electrical devices and equipment.
- ✓ Water infiltration in electrical enclosures and devices.
- ✓ Missing or improperly installed grounding systems.
- ✓ Outdated or missing fire and electrical safety devices
- ✓ Expired or missing surge protection devices.
- ✓ Issues that do not meet or exceed minimum safety code requirements.

### Diagnostic Measurements

Diagnostic measurements are taken at key points of your electrical system to monitor the following conditions:

- ✓ Abnormalities in voltage from the electrical service.
- ✓ Failure in critical safety devices such as GFCI or AFCI breakers or receptacles.
- ✓ Improperly wired point of use devices.
- ✓ Abnormal voltage due to loose connections in branch circuit wiring.





# **Home Plumbing System Check**

The home plumbing system check includes a comprehensive inspection of your home's plumbing system. From supply piping to waste piping and all fixtures in between, we monitor key components annually to identify issues before they become big problems. Our expert technicians will keep you in-the-know as to the latest advancements in plumbing technology.

### Visual System Check

We will visually check readily accessible areas of your home's plumbing system for the following conditions:

- Active or imminent leaks from pipe fittings, valves, and fixtures.
- ✓ Insecure mounting or attachment of plumbing fixtures and piping.
- ✓ Stop valves and emergency shut-offs worn, inoperable, or missing.
- ✓ Improper piping and performance of plumbing fixtures.
- ✓ Damaging or unhealthy levels of impurities in drinking water.
- ✓ Inadequate flow of waste piping systems.
- ✓ Unsafe or inefficient operation of water heating
- ✓ Issues that do not meet or exceed minimum safety code requirements.

#### **Diagnostic Measurements**

While the majority of your plumbing system check involves hands-on inspection of components and piping, there are a few diagnostic tests we administer during the visit. These measurements include:

- ✓ Testing water pressure for safe operating range.
- ✓ Toilet tank to bowl leak test.

- ✓ Basic water quality test.
- ✓ Electric water heater element test.





### **Heating & Cooling Semiannual System Check**

The heating and cooling system check is performed twice per year to make sure your equipment is ready for the extreme conditions the seasons have to offer. We perform a comprehensive check of critical operating components so that you can be proactive about repairs. Our expert technicians will keep you up to date with the latest energy efficient equipment and air purification technologies.

### Visual System Check

We will visually check each of your heating and cooling systems for the following conditions which could lead to unexpected failure:

- Dirty and clogged filters, heat exchangers, and blower compartments.
- Clogged, leaking, or improperly installed condensate systems.
- ✓ Insufficient airflow related to duct work issues.
- ✓ Refrigeration cycle performance issues.
- ✓ Evidence of refrigeration leaks.

- Damaged, worn, loose or failing electrical components.
- ✓ Inoperable or outdated humidification, dehumidification, or air purification systems.
- Missing, inoperable, or expired surge protection devices.
- ✓ Issues that do not meet or exceed minimum safety code requirements.

### **Diagnostic Measurements**

Part of the heating and cooling system check includes measurements which help determine the overall health and efficiency of your equipment. These measurements are recorded and referenced each visit and include the following:

- ✓ Air temperature ranges in heating and cooling (depending on the season).
- ✓ Motor amperages under load.
- ✓ Starting capacity tolerance.

- ✓ Supply voltage on all equipment.
- ✓ Refrigerant line set operating temperatures.
- ✓ Carbon monoxide levels related to fossil fuel burning equipment.
